

# Lanier Aquatics Invitational

**Host:** Lanier Aquatics

**Facility:** Frances Meadows Aquatics and Community Center, 1545 Community Way, NE, Gainesville, Ga. 30501, 770-533-5863. 10 lane, 25 yard pool with scoreboard. Eight lanes will be used for competition and two lanes will be used for warm up – warm down. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) . The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming & Georgia Swimming.

**Eligibility:** Open to all USA-registered swimmers and teams. All coaches must be USA-registered and certified and will be asked to show their registration credentials at the meet. All officials must wear their USA cards on deck and must present their USA Swimming officials card to the meet referee at check-in. All out of state teams entering this meet must be prepared to prove the USA registration of their swimmers, team and coaches before the start of the meet. Lanier Aquatics will not allow unregistered swimmers, coaches, officials and teams to participate in this meet. Swimmers attending this meet without a coach must notify the referee and make arrangements with an attending coach to act as their representative/supervisor and provide proof to that coach of diving safety certification.

**Rules:** The current USA Swimming, Inc., rules will govern the conduct of this meet unless otherwise noted. Deck Pass is acceptable proof of USA Swimming membership. The current Georgia Swimming scratch rule will be used (attached). Photos and videos may be taken of swimmers during the meet by parents or a professional photographer retained by the host club. All participants agree to be filmed or photographed by photographers designated by the meet host and to allow the meet host the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during, or after the period of participation in Georgia Swimming competitions to promote swimming and meets hosted by the meet organizer. If you do not wish to have your child(ren) photographed, you may withdraw your consent by informing the Meet Director before the start of the first day of the meet. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. Deck Changes (changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit when wearing just one suit in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or space designated for changing purposes) are prohibited Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coaches' areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and /or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.

**Format:** All events will be timed final events

**Age Divisions:** 8&U, 10 &under, Open (Note: Open events will be awarded by age groups – 12 & Under, 13-14 and 15&Over).

**Schedule:** Warm ups for 10 and younger swimmers will begin at 8:00 AM with the meet starting at 9:00 AM. Warm ups for the afternoon Open session will start not before 12:00 with the meet starting not before 1:00.

**Note:** The meet host reserves the right to combine the meet into one session if a low entry turnout occurs.

**Events and Entries:** Swimmers may enter five events.

**Limits:** The meet will be limited to the first 200 swimmers per session entered, however, the meet management reserves the right to determine the final number of swimmers accepted into this meet based on timelines as they develop during the entry process.

**Awards:** Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> place for 8&U, 10&U, 12&U, 13-14 and 15&Over.

**Entries:** Please submit entries via Team Manager. HY-TEK Meet Manager will be used. Email entries are encouraged (send to [jimyoung1@mindspring.com](mailto:jimyoung1@mindspring.com)). Be sure to send hard copy of entries and check by mail.

**Entry Fees:** \$4.50 per event. Out of state swimmers must pay the Georgia Swimming, Inc., surcharge of \$2.00 each. Make checks to Gainesville Parks and Recreation.

**Late Entries:** Late entries will be accepted at the meet for empty lanes only. Swimmers entering late must show proof of USA registration or complete a USA registration form, pay the \$72 registration fee plus the Georgia Swimming \$25 late registration fee. The \$72 registration fee will be refunded if the Georgia Swimming Registration Chairman later verifies that the swimmer was previously registered.

**Warm Ups:** Warm ups will be governed by the guidelines as adopted by Georgia Swimming, Inc. Teams will be assigned warm up lanes and times based on numbers per session.

**Safety Marshal:** The safety marshals will be the Frances Meadows Center guard staff.

**Officials:** The meet referee will be David Furlong – 404-615-8888, [atlfurlong@gmail.com](mailto:atlfurlong@gmail.com). Visiting officials are welcomed and encouraged. Please see meet referee upon arrival.

**Meetings:** There will be an officials meeting 30 minutes prior to the start of the meet. There will be a coaches meeting at 8:45 AM on Saturday. Other meetings will be held if necessary.

**Liability:** The City of Gainesville, Ga., Georgia Swimming, Inc., and USA Swimming, Inc., shall be free from any liabilities or claims arising by reason of injury to any person or loss of or damage of any kind to any personal property during the conduct of this meet or during travel to or from this meet.
